Dear Faith Leaders,

We are celebrating our one-year anniversary of the first-ever White House Faith Office! Last February 7th, President Trump signed an Executive Order creating the historic White House Faith Office and we couldn't be more grateful! The President famously says with joy, “We are bringing religion back to America!” *When faith is weak, our country is weak; but when faith is strong, America is strong.*

The critical mission of the White House Faith Office is to provide a voice of advocacy for our faith community by using the power of government to shape policy, impact culture, and protect faith. The good news is faith is rising in America! People are increasingly going back to worship services, Bible sales are up, youth are turning to faith in record numbers, *and the federal government is on your side again.*

In just ONE YEAR, we have reached 100,000 faith leaders in person through meetings, policy briefings, and Presidential events at the White House. We also went across the country and the world meeting with faith leaders in their own houses of worship. Through media platforms and your networks, we have reached more than 40 million lives! The message is clear: The faith community feels free to practice their religion under the Trump Administration and the policies we implemented directly impact our faith and walk with God.

YOU can take comfort in knowing President Trump is protecting your religious freedom.

- We created task forces to eradicate anti-Christian bias, combat anti-Semitism, and other forms of anti-religious bias, while ending the weaponization of government against all people of faith.

These task forces are raised to the highest level, with our Cabinet Secretaries serving as active members.

- The Religious Liberty Commission was created to define religion in order to secure and promote religious liberty. These entities are made up of a diverse group of faith leaders who have met quarterly over the year and will release an important report in May, which we will share with you.

You understand and celebrate the importance of having the Faith Office, but the legacy media asks why this office is necessary. For far too long, the federal government has discriminated against people of faith. The federal government should never be the biggest impediment to faith, it should be the biggest defender of faith, and that is exactly what we are doing. President Trump has expanded school choice, protected parents' rights, restored biological truth, uplifted families, ended illegal and divisive DEI policies, stopped taxpayer funding for abortion, restored free speech, stood with Israel, defended persecuted Christians from around the world, and has been the greatest advocate for PEACE.

- Established the Historic White House Faith Office with Senior Advisor to the President and Faith Director.
- Appointed Faith Directors and Liaisons in every department and agency to represent you.
- Pardoned Christian and pro-life activists who were jailed by the Biden Administration for praying and peacefully living out their faith.

- Issued an executive order restoring biological truth to the federal government affirming there are only two sexes – men and women.
- Protected parental rights in education and expanded school choice, including faith-based schools.
- Ended the use of federal taxpayer dollars to fund or promote elective abortion in the US and internationally.
- Issued Executive Order on foster care maximizing partnerships with faith-based groups and working to remedy state policies that prohibit qualified families for their religious beliefs.
- Awarded over \$100 million to promote healthy marriage, responsible fatherhood, and strong families which included faith-based organizations previously excluded.
- Reinstated our military members forced out of their service under Joe Biden over the COVID-19 mandate, including those discharged for religious objections.
- When President Trump learned of thousands of persecuted Christians in Nigeria, he used his platform to expose the atrocities, designated them as a Country of Particular Concern, and worked with the Nigerian government to strike those responsible for the attacks.

When you read through the full list of victories, you will be surprised at how much President Trump has done in one year and how much the previous administration did to chip away at your freedoms.
